### BLURB – what is this thing

We are looking for four artists/producers who live, work or play in the Dandenong Ranges to form this Cultural Leadership Committee with hillsceneLIVE Festival Director Gareth Hart.

The Committee will meet once per month, engaging in either an informal networking session, a professional industry workshop or shared studio practice (this avenue is also open to the wider arts community). Workshops will focus on key aspects of arts leadership including: cultural programming, community partnerships, marketing, and more.

Participants will then apply the skills gained through the workshops in assisting the management and implementation of a hillsceneLIVE festival in later in 2015!
