The best things come in small packages. To celebrate the relaunch of Burrinja after redevelopment we are launching a new annual opportunity for budding or established artists to participate in a non-acquisitive art prize celebrating small works of art.

The exhibition will take place in the Aerie Members Gallery on the first floor

Terms and Conditions of Entry

Eligibility

Who can enter?

- Professional, amateur, young and old and everyone in between

How many works can be entered?

Up to 4 works can be entered by an individual. Please be aware that we cannot guarantee that we will be able to hang a series of works together.

Entries will be accepted that comply with the following:

- Does not exceed the maximum size of 10" x 10" (25.4cm x 25.4cm) including any framing
- Can be hung on a wall – it can be 2 or 3 dimensional as long as it can be hung on the wall and doesn't pose a safety risk. No free standing sculpture, projection or video work can be accepted

However Burrinja reserves the right to exclude any work that:

- Exceeds the 10" x 10" size limitation including framing
- Cannot be displayed safely
- Could be considered offensive in terms of pornographic content, character denigration, racial, religious or gender prejudice. Judgement of the appropriateness of the work will lie with Burrinja's management and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Does not comply to Burrinja's policies and procedures

By entering this prize artists confirm that they are the owner and creator of the work(s) and that they have not breached copyright in the creation of the work(s). Burrinja accepts no liability for any breaches of copyright.

No refund of entry fees will be given should works not be accepted due to not meeting the terms and conditions of entry.

Online Entry

Only works registered via our online ticketing or at our boxoffice will be accepted

Online registrations open Tues 3rd March 2020

Online registrations close Wednesday 22nd April at Midnight

Entry fee for one work is \$25, \$35 for two works, \$45 for three works and \$55 for four works.

If you require return delivery, please ensure the work(s) weight no more the 4.5kg collectively.

An additional \$20 fee is charged at time of registration if you require works to be returned via post.

Hanging of the works

The exhibition will take place in the Aerie Members Gallery on the first floor.

Please ensure that the size of your work is no larger than 10x 10 inches including framing.

If works are oversized and we are unable to remove any oversized frames, we will not be able to hang the work.

Please indicate the orientation (portrait or landscape) of your artwork by including a directional arrow on your artwork label – this will ensure correct installation.

If your work is unmarked the Curator will hang the work using their discretion. We will be unable to correct the way it is hung after installation.

Framed works and stretched canvas must have D-type rings on the back for hanging. For unframed works on paper can be pinned. We recommend adding tabs that we can pin to the wall to reduce any damage to the surface of the work.

The positioning of the works is at the discretion of the Curator. Burrinja cannot guarantee that any series of works will be hung together.

Sale of Works and commissions

All works must be available for sale.

The price of the artwork must be set by the artist. Please ensure that the price set includes the commission.

All sales attract a 30% sales commission plus GST. For example, a \$100 artwork sale will attract a commission of \$30 plus GST to Burrinja. Burrinja receives \$33 & the artist receives \$67.

All payments to artists for sold work are made by Direct Deposit. Please ensure your current bank account details are provided on registration. Payments will be processed within 21 days of sale.

Judging

The judge's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

Returned Delivery

If you are unable to collect in person during these times, please select return postage option when registering. Please indicate and pay for these at registration.

All artworks are packaged for return to artists or buyers by Australia Post

They are returned within 14 – 21 days after the completion of the exhibition.

Burrinja will not be held responsible for any loss or damage caused to any work while in transit to and from the gallery.

All artworks will be handled by experienced staff. However, fragile works will be entered at artist's own risk.

Burrinja's insurance will cover works whilst on display at the gallery.

Reproduction of work

By entering this prize entrants agree to allow Burrinja to reproduce (at no charge) ANY entered artwork(s) in all publicity and promotion of the Small Works Exhibition, subject to Burrinja's discretion. Burrinja will not seek individual permission from artists. This does not affect the copyright status of the work. Burrinja will acknowledge the artist in any use of the works reproduced and will not misrepresent any works used. Images of the finalists' artwork will be published on Burrinja's website and social media sites including but not limited to Instagram, Facebook, Twitter & Flickr and may be used in printed material such as an annual report. Burrinja will not pass images of works onto a third party media or sponsor without the permission of the artist.
